Copilot in the Packages

At the moment, it doesn't look like it will make it into the 2025-09 packages.

There are a number of open questions:

- License compatibility (especially the agent that is included as binary, MIT licensed, but no source code available at the moment)
- Some part of the community would love this, another part of the community would not like this at all, so we would suggest to have an option for users to choose instead of directly include this as is in every package
- Communication is a challenge as well
- SAP would be interested in a collaboration, but how this would look like is still unclear, technically extracting core components and copilot as an extension would be interesting

F2F Meeting Q4 2025

Hannes gives a quick summary of some ideas and thoughts around hosting this in Stuttgart Vector would organize the steering committee meeting. Would be good if Hannes could check with the university about options for hosting the community day meeting. Whether this is a full day community meeting or just an evening event, is still up in the air. Suggestion is to focus the community day meetup in an afternoon/evening event.

Toolchain modernization interest group

Mark gives a quick update, the idea about writing a white paper is floating around. The most important background question that is coming up here: Do we (as the Eclipse IDE WG) recommend the Eclipse Platform, RCP, IDE as a modern platform for new projects? Or do we want to make a statement in the direction of keeping it alive for legacy projects?

The group exchanges thoughts around this topic, no decisions involved here, but the tendency is to not craft an official statement around this topic.
