Sep 16, 2025 Minutes

Approve Minutes of Sept 2nd, 2025 Meeting

- *Motion: Approve Minutes of Sept 2nd, 2025. Olivier moves and Martin seconds. No objection to unanimous approval.*

Discussions

- Zoom AI companion: unfortunately not set up in current meeting. Will be used in the next one.
- Infra issues : still in progress. Follow in:

- Membership :
 - Goather solutions (german company) as corporate sponsor (for 10k€) and will be proposed as guest for the next F2F meeting.
 - 15 good contacts are in “wait&see” mode -> must motivate them. Heiko mentions that initiative 31 has been overclaimed and we must adapt communication about it. He remarks that there is no real/official decision or conclusion about initiative 31. Thomas argues that the [presentation document](#) about risk in ecosystem is the last status. Despite the risk that the platform may no longer be delivered, people are not becoming members...
 - Olivier explains that one of its customer is only expecting updates for CVEs and don't really care about Initiative31. For this one, it needs only Platform update and IDE to make small updates.
 - Martin Lippert expects to get information from the different prospect that are in the pipe : do they need only IDE, Platform, ...?
- OCX 26 : CFP is opened.
- Things conference in Amsterdam : Thomas will attend. He has some free invitations -> Contact him
