- Stuttgart Event Schedule Updates
  - New Schedule, Costing Committee to meet on Wednesday Afternoon and Steering Committee to meet on Thursday
  - New corporate membership from Cobalt and Avenues for expanding corporate membership to be taken up

- IDE Program Plan Simplification
  - simplified version with two strategic goals and nine program objectives.
  - The plan focuses on value, sustainability, risk management, and industry support.
- Program Plans and Metrics Review
  - Release engineering now encompasses more than just Simrel, including Orbit and ChessJ.
  - Thomas to share a new dashboard in the next meeting.
- OCX Conference details primarily the CFP dates discussed.
- Copilot Funding
  - The team debated whether to fund GitHub Copilot pro accounts for committers - will have to reach a consensus.
- Java ACP Implementation Discussion
  - Development of a Java implementation for the Agent Communication Protocol (ACP), which would serve as an open-source library for AI agents.
  - Logistics of who hosts this to be decided if need be - AI working group or interested individuals?
