## Approve Minutes of previous Meetings

## Discussions

### Face-to-Face Meetings and Community Engagement

- Emphasized the value of face-to-face meetings for trust and collaboration
- Reviewed recent meeting:
  - Extended budget discussions led to an active maintenance plan.
- Agreed on the need to involve external companies and organizations relying on Eclipse IDE.
- Recent two-day event was effective:
  - Suggestions made for improved moderation and focus.
- Set next meetings for June (before summer break) and November.
- Noted the increasing business focus on open source projects while also highlighting financial challenges as a common issue.

### Steering committee update:

- Open Community Meetup:
  - Feedback: Average rating 9.3/10; overall positive.
  - Suggestions: Better pre-event agenda communication; improve directions to venue.

- Release Engineers:
  - Need to prepare and sign new contracts; highlighting the importance of risk management and collaboration with Ed and Christoph.
- GitHub Copilot Plugin:
  - The WG's position on GitHub Copilot plugin promotion was outlined, emphasizing the need for the Microsoft Copilot team to join the working group to facilitate regular meetings and data sharing.
- ACP Protocol & Infrastructure:
  - Discussed ACP protocol's potential to supersede GitHub Copilot plugin.
- Eclipse IDE Website:
  - Website updated for clarity and improved contribution visibility.
  - Community encouraged to submit new testimonials; importance of raising key issues in sync meetings with IT/infrastructure teams highlighted.
- Amazon Investment:
  - Jonah asked about Amazon's IT infrastructure investment; Thomas reported no specific details yet—focus remains on securing dedicated infrastructure for OpenVSX.

#### **Eclipse RCP Engagement Strategies:**

- Discussed strategies to engage and convert Eclipse RCP user companies into supporters.
- Thomas: Emphasized follow-ups with potential guests; proposed sharing white papers to spark interest and collect contacts.
- Johannes: Suggested compiling current outreach information and involving Francisco for insights from company interviews.
- Explored communication improvements within Eclipse IDE, e.g., pop-up messages on costs and funding needs.
