- Thomas update:

  - Thomas going to Embedded World, March 10-12 in Nuremberg - past embedded world was very effective for IDE WG goals
  - SBOM work done under EF (outside IDE WG) with some external funding, focussed on Eclipse IDE ecosystem
    - Various member companies need SBOM for the ecosystem, and have started looking at the work done by EF and have explored and developed alternative implementations too.
  - Meetings scheduled between EF and GitHub co-pilot teams to figure out the future path of the Eclipse co-pilot project.
  - Thomas encouraged project teams to consider participating in the GSoc (Google Summer of Code) initiative, with a deadline of February 11 for mentors, referencing Maria Teresa Delgado's email in the mailing list about the Eclipse Foundation process now hosted on GitLab at <https://gitlab.eclipse.org/eclipsefdn/emo-team/gsoc-at-the-ef>
- OCX:
  - BoF possibilities for Tue or Wed evening - ideal to have a BoF session on Wed, same day as Manoj (16:15) and Heiko (17:00). BoF's start at 19:30
  - Steering Committee meeting: TBD, maybe lunchtime. There seem to be many rooms available throughout conference
- Initiatives
  - Renesas, SAP, Vector, Broadcom, IBM gave overview of current investments and interest in ecosystem
