Approve Minutes of previous Meetings

Thomas steering committee update

Thomas provided an update on program management, focusing on membership pipeline management and new methods to attract and benefit members. He shared insights from recent discussions with companies using the Eclipse Platform, highlighting challenges in convincing organizations to support the working group, particularly regarding concrete benefits and addressing security concerns like the CRA and SOC 2 standards. Thomas noted ongoing discussions with high-priority companies.

He also explained the ongoing discussion inside the Eclipse Foundation to improve membership benefits and corporate sponsorship opportunities. The group discussed potential new business models for the Eclipse Foundation, including offering SBOM services.

OCX 2026 organization update

Thomas announced the upcoming face-to-face SC meeting at the OCX conference, encouraging attendees to invite Eclipse IDE users for discussions and to their BoF which will focus on "Eclipse Platform and IDE in the edge of AI".

We plan a face-to-face SC meeting before the BOF session on Wednesday evening, which will last 1 hour and 15 minutes. Mark suggested including updates on company situations, while Thomas proposed potentially adding a discussion about membership benefits. All participants should edit and contribute suggestions to the face-to-face team committee meeting agenda (Google Doc) before the next meeting/OC

SimRel Metrics and Platform Discussion

The team discussed metrics for SimRel projects, with Thomas presenting data showing mixed trends in contributor numbers and downloads. They examined discrepancies between website displayed metrics and internal data, with Thomas investigating the cause of these differences.

Use Google Meet for our SC meetings

Finally, the group agreed to try switching from Zoom to Google Meet for AI note generation, with Johannes proposing to test this for two meetings before making a decision.
